

Easy-to-Make Birdfeeder



Equipment needed:

1 cup peanut butter 1 cup birdseed 1 empty toilet paper roll... the cardboard part only!

About 3 feet of string or wire Plastic or metal spoon or knife

Paper plate

- 1. With your knife or spoon, smear peanut butter all over the outside of the empty toilet paper roll... The peanut butter should be really thick and does not have to be smooth.
- 2. Pour birdseed on the paper plate and roll the peanut butter covered roll through the birdseed. The birdseed should stick to the peanut butter, but you may need to press the birdseed down with your hands or with a knife or spoon.
- 3. Let dry for 15 minutes.
- 4. Cut a piece of wire or string and loop through the cardboard toilet paper roll. This is going to be what your new birdfeeder hangs on.

5. Hang your own birdfeeder from your favorite tree and watch the birds enjoy your own creation.

Advanced

1. Use a flat wooden heart with a drilled-out hole instead of the cardboard from the toilet paper roll. This gives your feeder shape and originality.
